

6 Steps

To Start your Hallie's Angels Chapter

1)

Set up a meeting time and place. You can meet at your house, school, or community center.

2)

Invite others. Use your boarding passes to tell friends about your Hallie's Angels meeting. Encourage them to tear off half of the ticket to invite one of their friends.

3)

Hold your first meeting. Tell friends more about Hallie's Angels and get them excited about taking action. Collect everyone's information and find out what causes and projects your chapter might be into. Check out "Organizing Your First Meeting" on the next page.

4)

Fill out the Hallie's Angels Team Application. Find this in your envelope marked "Urgent." Then go to LoveHallie.org/YourMark to make your mark by adding your chapter to the map. You can also see what other chapters are up to.

5)

Set goals. Use your Chapter Passport and Individual Passports to find causes that your chapter would like to help. Take the "What's Your Interest?" quiz found in the Journal section of your Organizer. (Make copies or print more at LoveHallie.org/Quiz) Once you choose a few causes, make goals about what you would like to do in the next month—and even the next year.

6)

Plan your first project. Once your Hallie's Angels chapter has formed, you can start to plan a project. In your organizer you'll find a few tools to help you.
