## Be Sure to Include:

- Event name and type
- Location, date, and time
- Contact information
- Event details

## Poster Tips:

- Use catchy phrases and graphics
- Make sure your poster isn't cluttered
- Stand across the room and try to read the sign: Are the words easy to read?
- When distributing posters, ask first if you can post your material
